Circle training in Sociocracy continues in June with **new classes starting in August.** This is an 8-hour training to provide a grounding in the governance method used at CGEV and costs only \$20-25 per person for the **entire training**. Contact <u>Becky</u> to register for August classes.

Planning & Development: Good news about the health of our "signature" trees! Some years ago, a forester examined them and told us that they were near the end of their lifecycle. This news has partly influenced our site planning. But in May, Jeffry and the Land Stewardship Circle asked an arborist (Guy Meilleur) to give us a second opinion on the oak, walnut, and pecan trees near pavilion. We were thrilled to learn that our old trees, and specifically the "Grandmother Oak," are healthy and should have long lives ahead of them. This will require reorienting and perhaps somewhat redesigning the Common House, but this is the right time for it, and certainly the right reason! Yay!

 P&D continues to manage the architectural and engineering design process. With our architect Jonathan Lucas and other consultants, we are preparing plans to accommodate our preferred construction materials and techniques to both maximize the benefits we see and reassure our bankers and builders. On the engineering side, many details are falling into place, such as plans for roads and pathways, the connection to Frazier Road, and possible pond renovation, along with the slow and detailed work of securing permits and filing with regulators (mostly done by our engineers). In the meantime, our loan application process continues to proceed, but slowly. Our support team at Centennial Mortgage (our actual lender) is working hard and skillfully to resolve various issues so that we can move
