Stagville Historic Site Tour: Understanding the Lives & Work of Enslaved People, October 19, 11am-1pm, 5828 Old Oxford Highway, Durham, NC

This historic site includes remnants of one of the largest plantations in NC and is dedicated to teaching about the lives and work of enslaved people who lived here. Herbalist and flower essence practitioner, Melanie Yukov, will offer an up-close-and-personal encounter with pine (pinus spp). She will discuss the benefits of this evergreen from wound healing, immune support, reducing inflammation and more, as well as go over spiritual uses and medicines made with this tree. You'll sip pine tea, learn how to make medicinal oil, and meditate with this plant to connect with, and gain knowledge about, the wisdom they share.
